The Novice league is for bridge students who have completed at least one year's tuition.

The leagues are split into divisions of not more than 4 teams, so there will be a maximum of 3 matches to be played over a 6 month period from November to April. The winning team from each division will be invited to play in a final held at Oxshott in May.

Four players are needed to form a team but additional players may be used as reserves or substitutes. Team members need not be members of the Surrey County Bridge Association or of the EBU.

Matches are played in team member's homes (or any other venue by mutual agreement). Matches are of 16 boards. The matches are an ideal opportunity to meet other bridge students in your area!

If you would like to enter, please complete an entry form (email or phone me if you need an entry form) and return it to me asap (latest by Fri 23rd Oct 2009). The entry fee is £8 per team, please make cheques payable to SCBA.

To ensure that entrants are bona fide students and novices you will need a signature from your teacher to confirm you have been playing no more than 4 years (and if playing in a club, ranked no higher than district master). There is an Intermediate League for more experienced players.
